APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Personal Statement
- Resume
- Valid LSAT, GRE, or JD-Next score
- Letter of Good Standing from current law school's dean
- Official law school transcript, including grades from most recent semester
- Two letters of recommendation, preferably from law school professors or advisors
- *Additional requirements are necessary for candidates interested in transferring into the Hybrid JD (HJD) Program. Please contact the Office of Law Admission for more information.*

ADVANCED STANDING

- No more than 30 credits of advanced standing will be awarded for courses completed at a previous law school
- Advanced standing is awarded on a case by case basis and is reviewed after the admission decision
- Any inquiries regarding transfer of credit should be directed to the Office of Academic Services

NON-ABA ACCREDITED SCHOOLS

- Students may transfer from a non-ABA accredited law school to Suffolk Law School
- The application is the same as for applicants seeking to transfer from an ABA-accredited law school
- Additional documentation may be necessary upon request

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Personal Statement
- Resume
- Letter of Good Standing from your current law school dean
- Letter from your current law school dean stating that credits earned as a Visiting Student at Suffolk University Law School will be applied toward your degree requirements at your current law school
- Copy of the front page of your Credential Assembly Service report via LSAC, showing your cumulative undergraduate GPA and LSAT score
- Official law school transcript submitted through LSAC's Credential Assembly Service
