## SUMMER/ EARLY FALL

- Take Admission Test (LSAT, GRE, or JD-Next)
- Draft Personal Statement
- Ask for Letters of Recommendation

## NOVEMBER

- Attend Suffolk Law's Open House

## SPRING

- Visit Suffolk Law's campus and observe a class

## MARCH 1

- HBCU Full-Tuition Scholarship Deadline

## FALL

- Start application to Suffolk Law
- Re-take Admission Test (if needed)
- Research Law Schools

## DECEMBER 1

- Application Deadline for Binding Early Decision (BED) Program

## FEBRUARY 1

- Application Deadline for Hybrid Online JD and Accelerated JD Programs

## APRIL 1

- Priority Application Deadline

- Complete our Online Application
- LSAT, GRE, or JD-Next Score
- Official transcripts from all higher education institutions via LSAC's Credential Assembly Service (CAS)
- 2-3 page Personal Statement
- Optional Addenda (Diversity Statement, Admission Test, or GPA)
- 2-3 Letters of Recommendation
- Resume
- Character & Fitness Addendum (*if applicable*)
- Fees (*Application fee, CAS fee, Law School Report fee*)
