McKinney – Vento definition:

- Unaccompanied: not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian
- Homeless: lacking fixed, regular and adequate primary nighttime residence
- Youth: applicants who are under the age of 24 and are unaccompanied and homeless or self-supporting and at risk of being homeless, can qualify for a homeless youth determination
 - Self-supporting: pays all living expenses, including fixed, regular, and adequate housing
 - At risk of being homeless: student's housing may cease to be fixed, regular, and adequate

Check <u>one</u> of the following options and provide the information requested:

Option 1: Attach official documentation verifying homelessness or risk of homelessness from one of the following:

- Director or designee of an emergency or transitional shelter, street outreach program, homeless youth drop-in center, or other program serving those experiencing homelessness
- The student's high school or school district homeless liaison or designee
- Director or designee of a project supported by a federal TRIO or GEAR UP program grant
- Financial aid administrator (FAA)

Please note: Documentation from sources listed above must be dated on or after July 1, 2024.

Option 2: If you cannot obtain documentation from one of the above listed individuals, submit the following:

• Attach a separate statement summarizing your unusual circumstances that result in your being selfsupporting, how you support yourself and your housing situation.

Please note: a Financial Aid Administrator may request a follow-up conversation before a determination is made. You will be contacted directly if this is necessary.

Option 3: If you do not qualify as an unaccompanied homeless youth, or youth at risk of homelessness – you must:

- Correct the information on your FAFSA and provide your parent(s) financial information.
- You and at least one parent must sign the FAFSA with your FSA ID and submit it for processing.
