If you're a domestic student, you can apply as test-optional. That means you can decide whether to send us your test scores. If you think your scores strengthen your application and accurately reflect your academic abilities and potential, you may choose to include them.

Please note that Suffolk does require test scores from homeschooled students.

We want to make this process as easy as possible if you choose to submit your standardized test results.
